## **Milwaukie Planning Commission Statement**

**The Planning Commission serves as an advisory body to, and a resource for, the City Council in land use matters. In this capacity, the mission of the Planning Commission is to articulate the Community's values and commitment to socially and environmentally responsible uses of its resources as reflected in the Comprehensive Plan**

The Planning Commission will take comment and make a recommendation to Mayor Bernard on the following questions:

1. Does a large cross-section of the community support the inclusion of a McLoughlin and/or Main Street alignment in the South Corridor Phase 2 SDEIS study?
2. Does a McLoughlin and/or Main Street alignment have merit with regard to the economic development and revitalization of downtown Milwaukie?

The Public Forum will be structured to provide a fair and open process for considering Mayor Bernard's questions. The Commission has established the following rules for this procedure:

- Written material (petitions, letters) will be reviewed by the Planning Commissioners if received by the Milwaukie Planning staff by June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2007.
- At the beginning of the meeting on June 12<sup>th</sup>, City and TriMet staff will present background information and detail on the proposed alignments.
- Public comment will be taken on a first come, first served basis.
- Each speaker will be limited to five minutes.
- Participants will be asked to address one or both of the questions, and are requested to refrain from using the limited time available for testifying about other tangential matters.
- The meetings will begin at 6 pm and conclude by 10 pm.
- At the close of the public comment period, there will be an hour-long Planning Commission discussion, with possible recommendations based on the two questions.
- The meetings will be videotaped and minutes will be prepared within three weeks of the meeting, and published following Planning Commission approval.
- The Planning Director will summarize the Commissioners' recommendations in a report to Mayor Bernard and City Council.
