## 85-year-old a victim of Aggravated Theft, Criminal Mistreatment – adult daughter arrested

On March 25, 2010, after an extensive criminal investigation that began in September 2009, Milwaukie Police detectives arrested Janet Gay Durkee (03-29-48) on felony charges of Aggravated Theft I, and Criminal Mistreatment I.

Janet Durkee was arrested for systematically taking more than \$224,000 over a five month period from her 85-year-old mother's bank accounts, leaving the elder destitute. The victim of these crimes is 85-year-old Geneva E. Smith who resides in Milwaukie.

Milwaukie Police received a referral from Adult Protective Services, a component of Oregon Department of Human Services. Upon contacting the elderly victim, it was determined she was a crime victim. Milwaukie Police Detectives completed an extensive investigation, including a search warrant of properties in La Pine, Oregon. It was discovered the elderly victim had been bilked of her life's savings, and a large sum of property.

Durkee's alleged exploitation of Geneva Smith's finances began after the 85-year-old victim had sustained serious injuries in a fall and was no longer able to care for herself.

Detectives arrested Janet Gay Durkee at the Clackamas County Court House in Oregon City. There was probable cause to arrest Durkee for the criminal charges of Criminal Mistreatment I and Aggravated Theft I. "Not only as a police agency, but also as a community, we have a responsibility to ensure the safety and well-being of people most vulnerable to financial exploitation, and other abuses," said Milwaukie Public Information Officer Ulli Neitch.

During the 75<sup>th</sup> Oregon Legislative Assembly – 2009 Regular Session, House Bill 2442 established broader mandatory reporting requirements to better serve elderly adults and adults with developmental disabilities.
